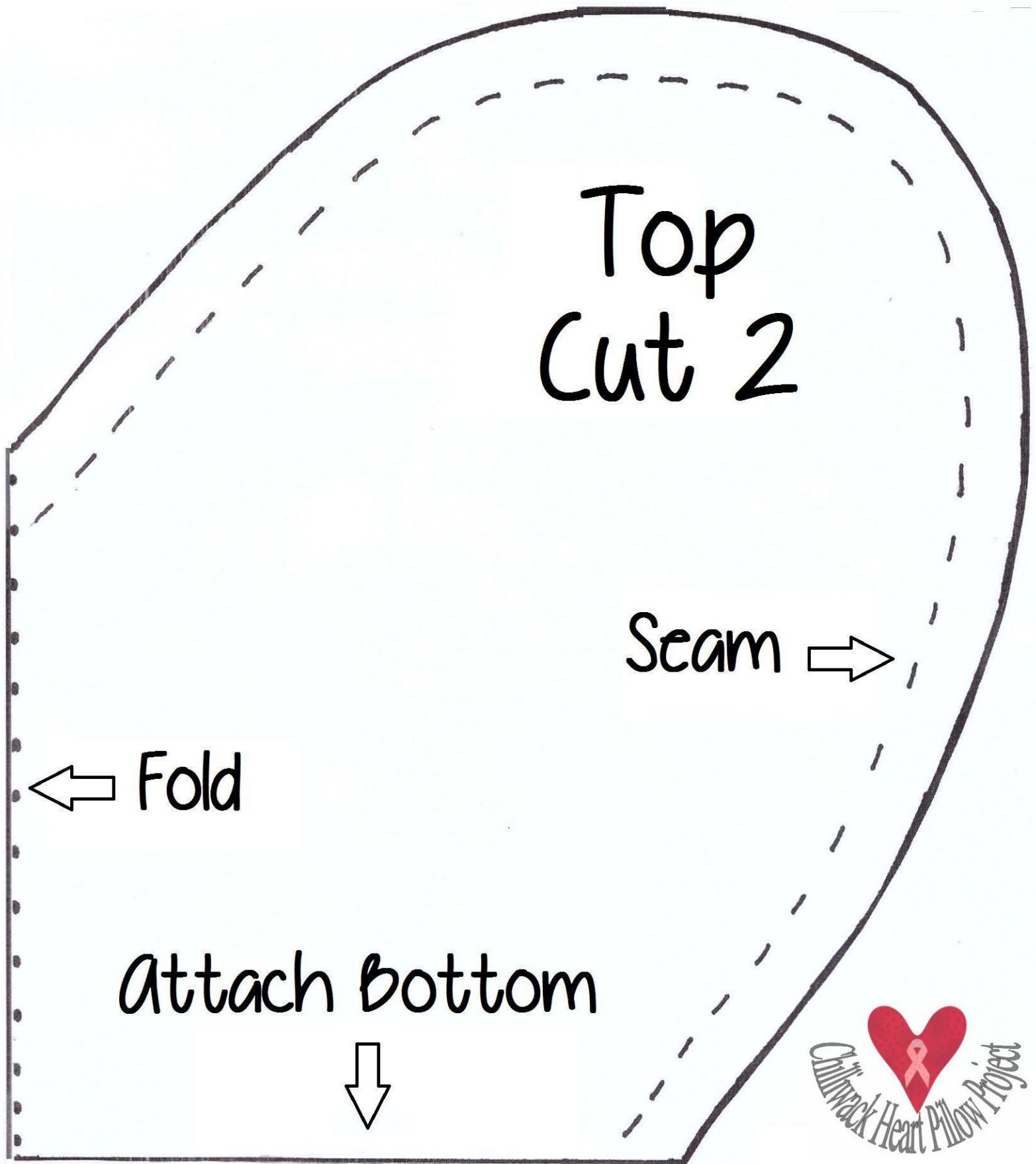
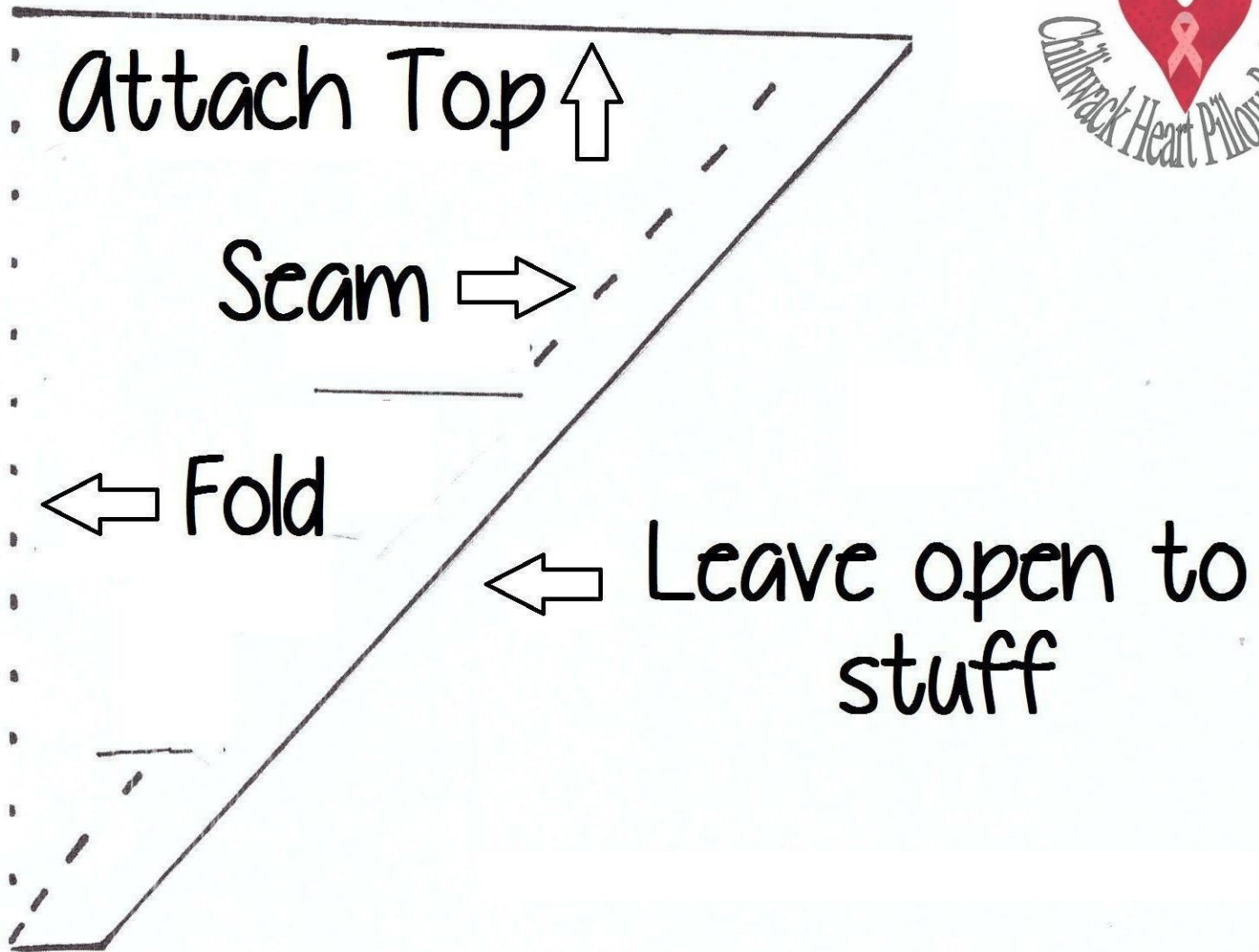


Breast Cancer Heart Pillow Pattern





Directions

- Use soft cotton fabrics. The finished pillow should be washable.
- You will need two pieces of fabric, each approx. 16"x20" (40 cm x 50 cm)
- Pin pattern to fabric and cut. The seam allowance is already included.
- Place the two heart shapes right sides together and stitch all around, leaving approx. 4" (10 cm) open.
- Trim excess fabric at the tip and clip seam allowances at the curves and the upper inside corner.
- Turn pillow through the opening.
- Press lightly and stuff with approx. 170 g of washable fibrefill. It is important to use this amount. If the pillow is too soft, it will not work the way it is supposed to.
- Stitch opening closed.
